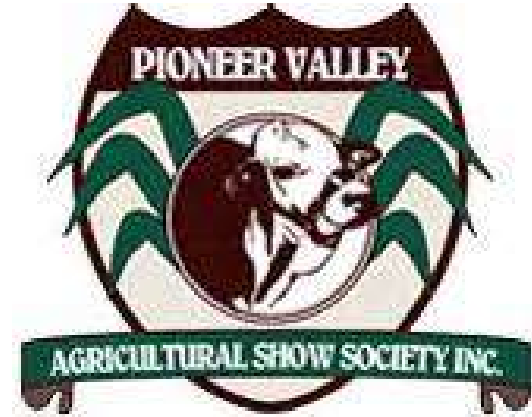

Rules

1. Presentation - trash removed from eyes, clean cut bases, no aerial roots, side shoots or damaged eyes.
2. Even sticks in length and thickness.
3. Paddock-grown cane will only be accepted.
4. Stand over cane will not be accepted for judging.
5. Any children of the district may enter cane in Special Junior Classes.
6. Cane for CCS Judging is to be presented as 6 sticks in any one (1) recommended variety - 1.4 metres with tops removed.
