Plane Creek Mill processed just over 62,700 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to just under 182,000 tonnes.

Showers again hindered some harvesting operations across the district, causing cane supply shortfalls during the week.

The rotary juice screen drive shaft failed early on Saturday afternoon resulting in an extended stop over the weekend.

Average weekly CCS came in at 14.14 units, and bin weights climbed from the previous week to average 3.98 tonnes.

The highest CCS honour for the week went to a rake of KQ228 fifth ratoon cane from the Ilbilbie productivity area, with a CCS of 16.55 units.
