Comments:

Plane Creek Mill processed just over 39,500 tonnes of cane for the week, bringing the season total to just over 564,500 tonnes.

Average weekly CCS came in at 15.25 units – a slight increase of 0.17 of a unit on the previous week.

Bin weights increased on the previous week, to average 4.11 tonnes.

The mill will be undertaking a two-hour shredder tip turn on Tuesday 10 August.

The highest CCS honours for the week went to a rake of Q240 plant cane from the Koumala productivity area with a CCS of 17.60 units.
